In the 3rd quarter, we experienced 26 terminations and assigned 23 spaces. Our turnover ratio decreased slightly from 4.2% in 2021 to 3.92% in 2022.

The waitlist has 343 total applications on file (compared to 320 in the 3rd quarter of 2021).

Dry Storage

Dry storage had a 98.1% occupancy at quarter-end, which is 2.3% greater than the 3rd quarter of 2021.

59 trailers are currently being stored in the Dry Storage Facility compared to 50 in 3rd quarter of 2021.

Total boat handling moves by the forklifts for this quarter were 5203

- 2.3% decrease from the 3rd quarter of 2021
- Launch activity was down .5% from the 3rd quarter of 2021

The launch reservation usage was up 5% from the 3rd quarter of 2021; this is attributed to our launch appointment policy.

• Reservations are required during all operating hours

Equipment updates and repairs.

- Forklift repairs: Wiggins experienced a hydraulic leak from the steering column
- Launcher repairs: None
- The staff has maintained the launchers and forklifts this quarter per the maintenance schedule with assistance from the Maintenance Department. The team has maintained the wash pad area daily (rinsing it off), turned the valve, and cleaned the trench bucket weekly.

Public Launch

Round trips in the 3rd quarter of 2022 show a 2% increase from 2021

• 34 more round trips in 2022

One-way launches show a decrease of 1% from 2021

• 4 fewer one-way trips in 2022

Guest Moorage

The total number of boats decreased by 17% (413 boats), and the total number of nights decreased by 16% (680 nights) during the 3rd quarter of 2022.

There were 44 reservations during the 3rd quarter of 2022 compared to 54 in the 3rd quarter of 2021. The reservation program accounted for 58 nights in the 3rd quarter of 2022 compared to 86 nights in the 3rd quarter of 2021.

Fuel Dock

Total Gallons pumped: decreased by 4% or 9,756 fewer gallons compared to 2021.

- Gasoline increased by 7%
- Diesel decreased by 17%

Maintenance: Annual line, leak, and monitor testing conducted for the fuel dock.

Pay at the pump usage accounted for 57% of the total gallons pumped in the 3rd quarter of 2022, compared to 64% in the 3rd quarter of 2021.
