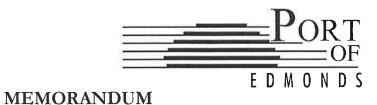
## SUBJECT: QUARTERLY REPORT SUMMARY

The following is a summary of 2nd quarter 2016:

- Public Launch activities compared to 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter 2015 were down 20% (40) on one way's and up 11% (56) on round trips compared to 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter 2015.
- In guest moorage, the number of boats in 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter 2016 increased by 6% (39) compared to 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter 2015. Number of nights also increased from 995 in 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter 2015 to 1073 in 2016 or 8%. The number of groups utilizing guest moorage during 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter 2016 stayed consistent with 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter 2015 at 6. The number of vessels that were a part of those groups decreased by 26% from 72 to 53. Number of nights for groups also decreased by 31% from 163 to 113.
- Fuel dock had some changes during 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter. In response to a fuel survey conducted during 1<sup>st</sup> quarter, a decision was made to go out to bid and switch from E10 with ValvTect to non-ethanol fuel without ValvTect. The switch was made on June 23, 2016. On that day, unleaded prices increased by \$0.362 per gallon. The Port's diesel still has ValvTect additive. Unleaded gallons sold during 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter 2016 decreased by 10% compared to 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter 2015. Diesel gallons sold increased by 26%. Based upon six price verifications during 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter 2016 average unleaded without tenant discount was \$2.82 compared to \$3.47 in 2015. 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter 2016 average for diesel without tenant discount was \$2.85 compared to \$3.14 in 2015. Simple average for 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter at all facilities surveyed (Edmonds, DesMoines, Kingston, Shilshole, Everett, Elliott Bay, Poulsbo, Brownsville) was \$2.80 for unleaded and \$3.00 for diesel.
- The boatyard stall usage is up by 49% or 274 days compared to 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter 2015. Round trip hauls are down 7% (6) compared to 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter 2015. Sling-time and pressure wash was down by 18% or 5 fewer boats compared to 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter 2015. Sling-time no pressure wash up by 29% or 13 boats compared to 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter 2015.

### Water Moorage and Dry Storage:

- Water moorage financial occupancy according to revenues was 96% YTD as of the end of 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter 2016. Financial occupancy year to date as of the end of 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter 2015 was 95%.
  - o 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter terminations for the past three years were; 26 in 2014, 21 in 2015 and 31 in 2016 for a turnover ratio of 4.68%.
  - o 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter assignments for the past three years were; 61 in 2014, 40 in 2015, and 43 in 2016.
- Dry storage financial occupancy according to revenues was 89% YTD as of the end of 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter 2016. Financial occupancy YTD as of the end of 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter 2015 was 88%.
  - o 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter terminations for the past three years were; 10 in 2014, 11 in 2015, and 12 in 2016 for a turnover ratio of 5.15%.
  - o 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter assignments for the past three years were; 56 in 2014, 62 in 2015 and 45 in 2016 for a turnover ratio of 5.15%
