### **Industry Context**

MMA Data: 7% decrease in saltwater fishing boat purchases in Washington State. In all other sales categories (power, sail, towboats, etc.) Washington shows triple the country average for sales.

Boating continues to be an activity that allows for proper social distancing during pandemic times, and data shows new participants are entering the market.

### **Operational Adjustments**

The Port instituted a 'No Mask, No Service' policy in the customer touchpoint areas, including marina operations, the fuel dock, and dry storage. This change aligns with the Washington State Governor's mandate and promotes a safe environment for both the Port staff and customers. Additionally, the Port increased signage along the boardwalk and promenade to promote face coverings; overall, we have seen an uptick in compliance over the quarter.

Our Dry Storage team has instituted additional safety measures with new hand sanitizing stations and increased pedestrian signage. With safety as our top priority, the new roped walkways help guide visitors to use the appropriate access points – in short, this new system keeps Port customers away from the forklifts.

In the 3rd quarter, we experienced 26 terminations and assigned 24 spaces. Our turnover ratio decreased from 4.98% in 2019 to 3.92% in 2020.

The waitlist has 234 total applications on file (compared to 134 in the 3rd quarter of 2019).

### **Dry Storage**

During the 3rd quarter, dry storage had a 94% occupancy rate compared to 98% in the 3rd quarter of 2019.

50 out of 51 trailer spaces are occupied: 98% occupancy.

Total boat handling moves by the forklifts for this quarter were 5214

- 2903 were weekend moves, and 2311 were weekday moves.
- That is an 8% decrease from the 3rd quarter of 2019

Launch activity was down 2.5% from the 3rd quarter of 2019. Wash down area use was down 17.5% from the 3rd quarter of 2019.

The call ahead service usage was up 99% from the 3rd quarter of 2019; this is attributed to our appointment policy during COVID.

- From 7 am to 3 pm, launch by appointment only
- From 3 pm to 5 pm, first come, first served launches

Equipment updates and repairs.

- Forklift repairs: Wiggin's fan clutch repair and wire harness replacement
- Launcher repairs: None
- Staff has maintained the launchers and forklifts this quarter per the maintenance schedule with assistance from the Maintenance Department. The staff has maintained the wash pad area daily (rinsing it off), turning the valve, and the trench bucket has been cleaned weekly.

### **Public Launch**

Round trips in the 3rd quarter of 2020 show a 10% increase from 2019

• 188 more round trips in 2020

One-way launches show an increase of 5% from 2019

• 13 more one-way trips in 2020

### **Guest Moorage**

The total number of boats increased by 34% (647 boats) and the total number of nights increased by 29% (926 nights) during 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter 2020.

The reservation program saw a minor uptick over last year. There were 69 reservations during the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter of 2020 compared to 59 in the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter of 2019. The reservation program accounted for 105 nights total in the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter of 2020 compared to 103 nights in the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter of 2019.

### **Boatyard + Travelift**

Travelift round trips increased by 49% (36 more) with 110 in 2020 compared to 74 in 2019.

Sling time with pressure wash decreased by 9% (3 less) with 31 in 2020 compared to 34 in 2019. Sling time with no pressure wash decreased by 18% (9 less) with 40 in 2020 compared to 49 in 2019.

Stall usage increased by 63% (598 more days)

49 pressure wash treatments were done this quarter. This number is up 44% from the 3rd quarter of 2019 (15 more). There were 33 more pressure washes than in 2019, which contributes to additional treatments.

### **Fuel Dock**

Total Gallons pumped: increased by 1.10% or 2,235 more gallons compared to 2019.

- Gasoline increased by 23%
- Diesel decreased by 24%

<u>Maintenance</u>: Fuel dock pump calibration was completed by Mascot. Annual line, leak, and monitor testing conducted for the fuel dock

### Washington State Department of Ecology


