## DID YOU KNOW? FIVE SALMON FACTS

1. Salmon are anadromous which means they can live in fresh or salty water.

2. After feeding and growing, they migrate back to the exact place where they were born to reproduce spawn.

3. Salmon can change color. They can be three different colors over the course of their life.

4. A female spring Chinook salmon can carry more than 4,000 eggs.

5. Salmon do not eat any food during the time they swim upstream to spawn.
