PORT BOATYARD: EASY TO USE AND EASY ON THE ENVIRONMENT

We hear about it more and more. Washington State marine, lake and river environments are in trouble. Many species of fish, birds, mammals, invertebrates and even some aquatic plants are in serious decline. A leading cause of this degradation is toxic pollution which is resulting in greater regulations for impaired waterways. Unfortunately, even a local pollution source can have far-reaching consequences. Some marine-grade products, even in small quantities, are toxic compounds that need to be handled carefully to prevent entry into our surrounding waters. Heavy metals such as copper, zinc, lead and tin are of special concern because of their persistence in the environment. While safer alternatives exist for some products, for other uses there are still no environmentally-safe substitutes. Some marine products such as antifouling bottom paint are specifically designed to kill or discourage certain forms of marine life from attaching to the bottom of your boat. If discharged into the water they continue to work, putting salmon, shellfish and other resources at risk.



Regular maintenance on your boat is important to preserve your boat *and* the environment. The Washington State Department of Ecology requires ground tarps for every boat in a boatyard. The Port of Edmonds provides plastic at current cost for this purpose. We also have plastic available for full enclosure of your boat if you are going to be doing sanding or spray painting. In addition, we have shop vacuums, brooms, dust pans, and secondary containment containers available for you to check-out during your stay in the yard. All these items assist with containment and daily clean-up under your boat, which keeps the metals and your bottom paint from entering Puget Sound waters. Please feel free to ask Port staff if you have questions about how you can contain debris and do the right thing for the environment when in the boatyard.
