2023 Marina Rates

2023 Moorage & Dry Storage Rates

New rates will go into effect January 1, 2023 and can be found on the Port's website: www.portofedmonds.org.

Tenant Security Deposits

Deposits will be adjusted to match new 2023 rates. This adjustment will appear on your January statement as line item Deposit-Charge-SECURITY DEPOSIT.

Other Charges

Please note that other operational rates such as Travelift, boatyard, and launch rates will also be changing effective January 1st. See website for details.

2023 Parking Permits

It's time to secure your 2023 parking permits! **Starting December 12th,** passes will be available for pick up at the Marina Operations service window. Tenants are allotted two per slip; you can purchase a third for \$50.00 + tax. Please remember that the Port must have the following documents on file:

- 1) Current insurance declaration page
 - \$500,000 worth of coverage for watercraft liability and pollution/fuel spill liability.
 - You must provide supplemental proof of coverage if pollution or fuel spill liability is not explicitly outlined on your declarations page.
 - The Port of Edmonds listed as an additionally insured party.
- 2) Current WA State registration or Coast Guard Documentation

Please grab your new passes by February 28th, as the 2022 version officially expires on March 1st, 2023. If you have questions, don't hesitate to contact our Marina Operations Office- we are happy to assist!
