2019 RATE CHANGE

2019 Moorage & Dry Storage Rates

New rates went into effect January 1, 2019 and can be found on the Port's website: portofedmonds.org.

Tenant Security Deposits

Deposits were adjusted to match new 2019 base rates. This adjustment appeared on your January statement as line item Deposit-Charge-SECURITY DEPOSIT.

Other Charges

Some operational rates such as Travelift, boatyard and launch rates, had minor increases. All rate schedules are available at each office and posted on our website.

BOAT SHOW TRAFFIC HACKS

Your excitement for the Seattle Boat Show may be tempered by the coinciding Alaskan Way Viaduct closure. Although the traffic pinch will undoubtedly be worse than normal, don't let the sky-is-falling pessimism of "via-doomers" dissuade you from attending the biggest and best boating party of the year! Here are tips for maximizing show enjoyment and minimizing road angst.



- 1. Work downtown? Don't fight the traffic.** Stay after work and enjoy the show while the traffic clears out. The show is open until 8pm on weekdays and 9pm on Fridays.
- 2. If your schedule allows, come mid-week and midday.** Savvy show attendees know that this is the best time to see the show as dealers, brokers, and factory reps have more time to give you their undivided attention.
- 3. Boat to the show!** Drop anchor at Bell Harbor Marina for a night or two. From there it's a short walk, Lyft ride or pedicab trip to CenturyLink Field Event Center.
- 4. Leave the driving to Lyft and transit.** Lyft is committed to helping Seattleites navigate the viaduct closure and is offering a \$2.75 discount (the cost of a transit ticket) on all shared rides to and from select transit centers.
- 5. Plan a staycation.** Purchase the 9-Day BIG pass (only \$30) and book a few nights with one of the show's hotel partners who offer Seattle Boat Show discounts.
- 6. Gather your yacht club friends and carpool.** Buy tickets online and receive free parking at Mariners garage.
- 7. Catch the Sounder.** The North Line runs four daily roundtrips between Edmonds and King Street Station. King Street station is just a few steps away from the north entrance to the show at CenturyLink.

2019 PARKING PERMITS

Parking permits are now available for pick up in the Marina Operations office. You must meet the following requirements to receive your new permits:

- 1.) You must have current insurance on file with us that meets our requirements in full – meaning \$500,000 of watercraft liability as well as a minimum of \$500,000 pollution or fuel spill liability included. If pollution or fuel spill liability is not specifically outlined on your declarations page you must provide supplemental documentation outlining this coverage.
- 2.) You must have current WA State registration or Coast Guard Documentation on file with us. If your boat is federally registered with the Coast Guard, you must provide us with current Coast Guard documentation.
