2019 KING FISHING OPPORTUNITIES



Marine Area 9 – Admiralty Inlet

July 25-July 28

Chinook – min. size 22".
Other salmon species – no min. size. Daily limit 2.
Only 1 hatchery Chinook may be retained. Release chum, wild Coho, and wild Chinook.

Season may be extended if sufficient Chinook quota remains.

Marine Area 10 – Seattle/Bremerton Area

July 25-Aug. 31

Chinook – min. size 22".
Other salmon species – no min. size. Daily limit 2.
Only 1 hatchery Chinook may be retained. Release chum and wild Chinook.

Season may close earlier if Chinook quota is attained.

OPERATION DRY WATER



With the holiday weekend approaching we want to remind everyone that operating a boat while under the influence of alcohol and/or drugs is not only unsafe—it's illegal. Piloting a boat with a blood alcohol concentration of .08 or higher, just like in a car, is against the law. Washington state's Boating Under the Influence (BUI) law applies to all boats including kayaks, canoes, rowboats and inflatable fishing rafts. Under the state BUI law, if a law enforcement officer suspects a boat operator to be intoxicated, he or she can require a breath or blood test.


- The state's legal alcohol limit is .08 and for marijuana, it's .05 nanograms.
- Refusing to take a breath test is a civil infraction with a maximum fine of \$2,050.
- If found guilty of operating a boat under the influence, the penalty is a gross misdemeanor punishable by a maximum fine of \$5,000 or 364 days in jail.
- A BUI is considered a prior offense for later DUI convictions.
