PARKING ON PORT PROPERTY

On most occasions, finding parking at the Port of Edmonds is easy. If you are a tenant, you display your parking permit on the rearview mirror and park in any of the parking spaces that are yellow striped throughout the facility. If the yellow spaces fill up, you can also park in the white striped areas which are also there for visitor parking.

If you are planning a trip and need to leave a vehicle in the parking lot, please let Port staff know the license and model of your vehicle and what the length of your stay will be. When security is aware that a vehicle will be left overnight, they can keep close watch on it. Make sure that your current parking permit is displayed. Park the vehicle in areas furthest away from the gates so that fellow boaters who are actively visiting their boats and loading and unloading can have the closest access to the gate.

HIRING COMMERCIAL VENDORS

Are you planning a clean-up or installation project on the boat this year? When having maintenance on the boat accomplished, a boat owner must determine whether it's worth the risk to utilize casual labor. What's casual labor? Well - it could be a relative, an acquaintance, or someone who only takes cash – avoiding the higher costs that are inherent to running a business within the existing federal, state and city laws. In all these scenarios, the boat owner may receive services cheaper, but is it worth the risk?

There is much higher risk and liability to the boat owner should a claim be made related to damage or injury while these persons are on Port property. Any environmental mishaps, injuries, damage or security breaches on Port property can become the liability of the boat owner. Although Port regulations acknowledge that boat owners sometimes choose to use casual labor for incidental services such as; washing, detailing or carpet cleaning, it's never allowed for work that is considered hazardous or of a technical nature. This type of work requires the performer to be on the Port's vendor list and comply with commercial work rules on Port property.

The Port of Edmonds does not recommend use of any specific businesses, but maintains a list for customer use and reference of commercial vendors who have provided the Port with proof of insurance, are committed to following Best Management Practices for the marina, boatyard and dry storage, maintain City business license and follow all Port, local, state and federal requirements appropriate to their business. Commercial vendors who meet these requirements have access to the Port docks and are authorized to perform work on Port property.
