LOAN-A-SLIP & SUBLEASE

Are you planning on being out of your slip for a weekend, or even two weeks? If so, consider participating in the loan-a-slip program. During peak season, many visiting boaters are looking for overnight moorage. Once the guest moorage areas fill up, Port staff look for available slips on the other docks to accommodate guests.

If you put your slip in the loan-a-slip program, we may be able to use it to accommodate a visiting boat and credit your account for that daily use. It's a win for you and for the visiting boater who might not otherwise find available space.

If you are planning on being out of your slip for one to six months and want to offer your slip for sublease, let us know. You remain responsible for your monthly payment to the Port, and the sublessee pays you an amount not to exceed the total amount billed to you by the Port. Some paperwork is necessary so that the Port can confirm the agreement between the two parties and verify registration and insurance of the sublessee.

PREVENT SPILLS

Spring is coming! Time to start thinking about conducting maintenance and starting up the engines, changing engine oil, checking fluid levels, changing fuel filters and completing routine inspections. Sometimes drips are left behind after maintenance. Bilge maintenance is extremely important in preventing spills in the water. Discharging any amount of fuel, oil, grease, and even soaps or detergent is illegal and can bring a hefty fine.

Keep your engine tuned to minimize oil leaks. Check that clamps and filters are seated properly. Place an oil-absorbent pad under your engine. Use an oil-absorbent bilge sock near your pump. Wipe up spills, drips and splatters right away. You must periodically check these products for oil saturation and replace as needed. Remember to keep your boat and the waters clean and protect the environment!
